# James F. Atwood Dies at Age 82; Was Ohio Senate Conservationist

James F. Atwood, 82, a retired Columbus attorney and former state senator widely known as a conservationist, died Wednesday at his home, 4426 Shields Ave.

Atwood, a 50-year member of the League of Ohio Sportsmen, was regarded as "father" of many of Ohio's fish and game laws.

A NATIVE OF West Virginia, Atwood grew up in Muskingum County and graduated from Ohio State University's arts and law colleges.

He set up law practice in Columbus in 1907.

He served two terms in the Ohio Senate, in 1921 authoring the bill allowing municipalities to levy a sewer tax so they could operate and maintain disposal plants and sewer systems.

HE WAS chairman of the finance committee in 1923-1924.

Atwood was credited with drafting the bills providing for the first Ohio hunting and fishing licenses.

Interested in all facets of conservation, he was a former

secretary of the League of Ohio Sportsmen and its president in 1917-1918 and in 1947-1948.

HE WAS A member of North Methodist Church.

Surviving are his wife, Mary C.; a son, James F. Atwood Jr., Cincinnati; two daughters, Mrs. Robert H. Wade, Xenia, and Mrs. Ben Heber Jr., Columbus; eight grandchildren, and seven great-grandchildren.
