James F. Atwood, 82, a retired Columbus attorney and former state senator widely known as a conservationist, died Wednesday at his home, 4426 Shields Ave.

Atwood, a 50-year member of the League of Ohio Sportsmen, was regarded as "fa-"ther" of many of Ohio's fish and game laws.

A NATIVE OF West Virginia, Atwood grew up in Muskingum County and graduated from Ohio State University's arts and law colleges.

He set up law practice in Columbus in 1907.

He served two terms in the Ohio Senate, in 1921 authoring the bill allowing municipalities to levy a sewer tax so they could operate and maintain disposal plants and
